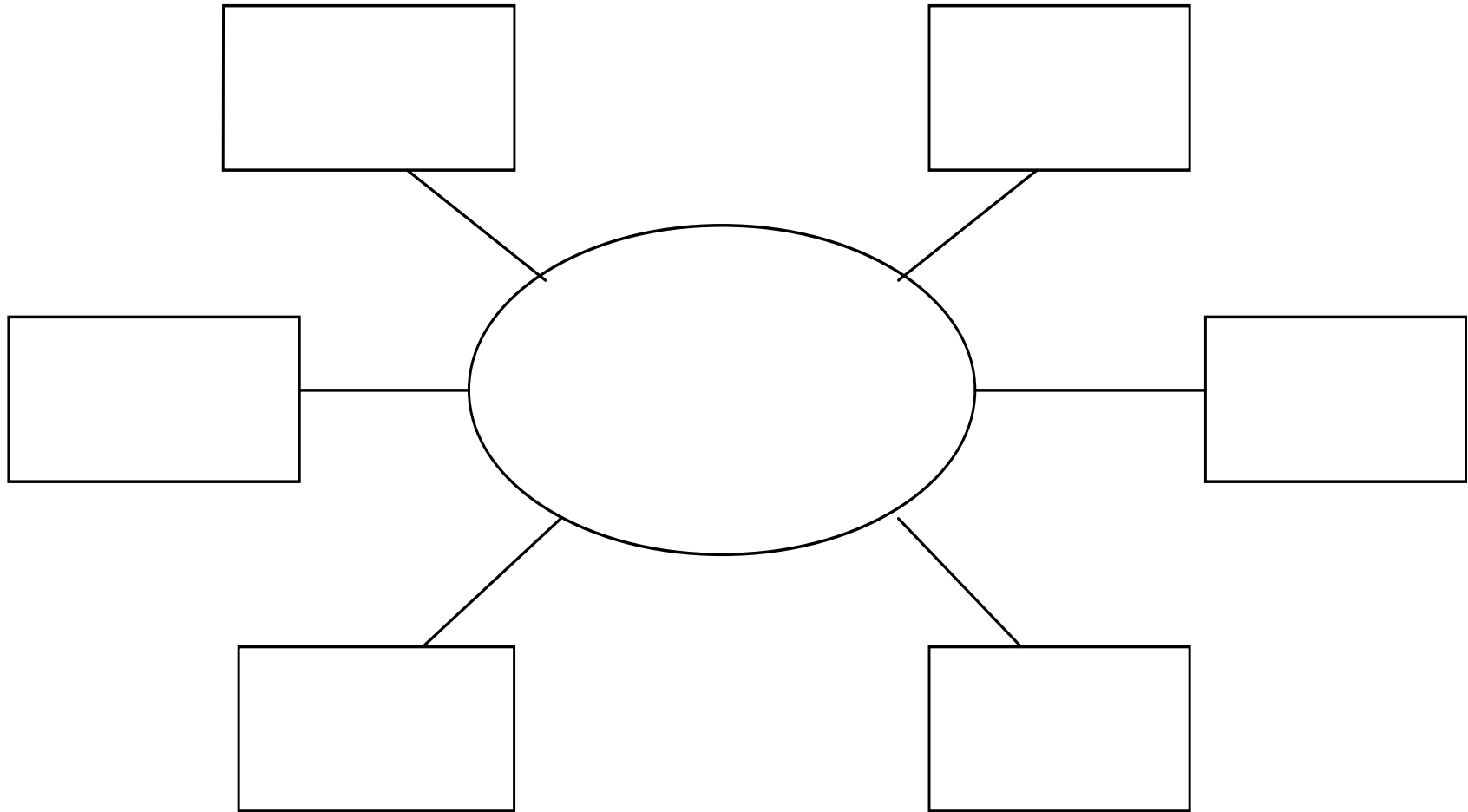

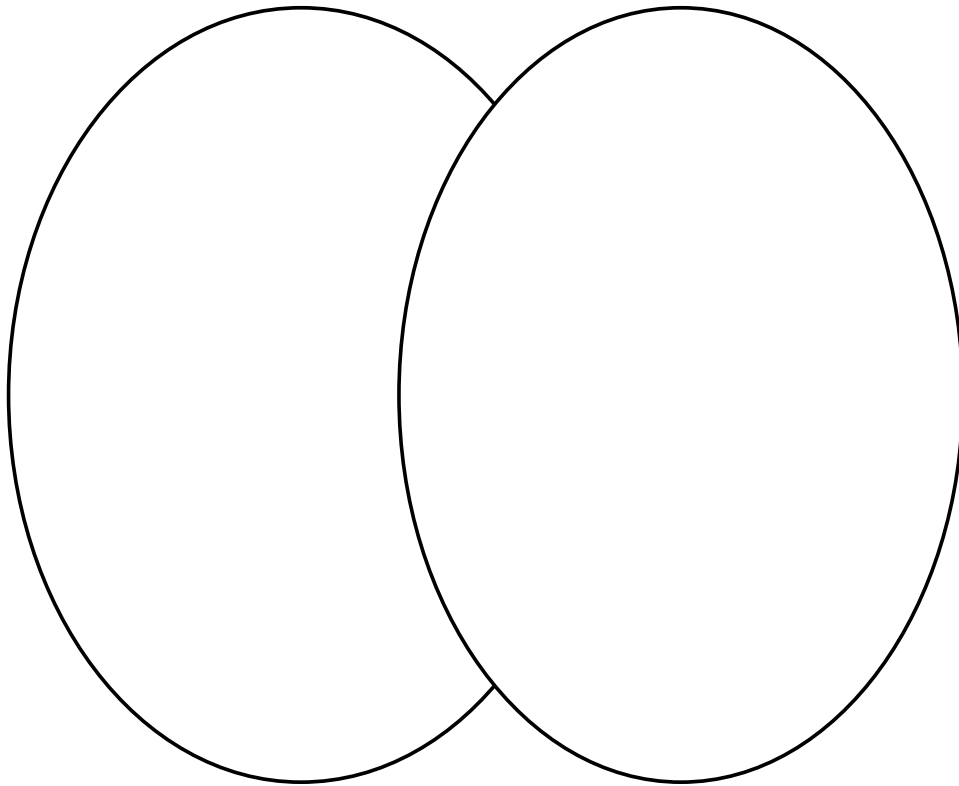

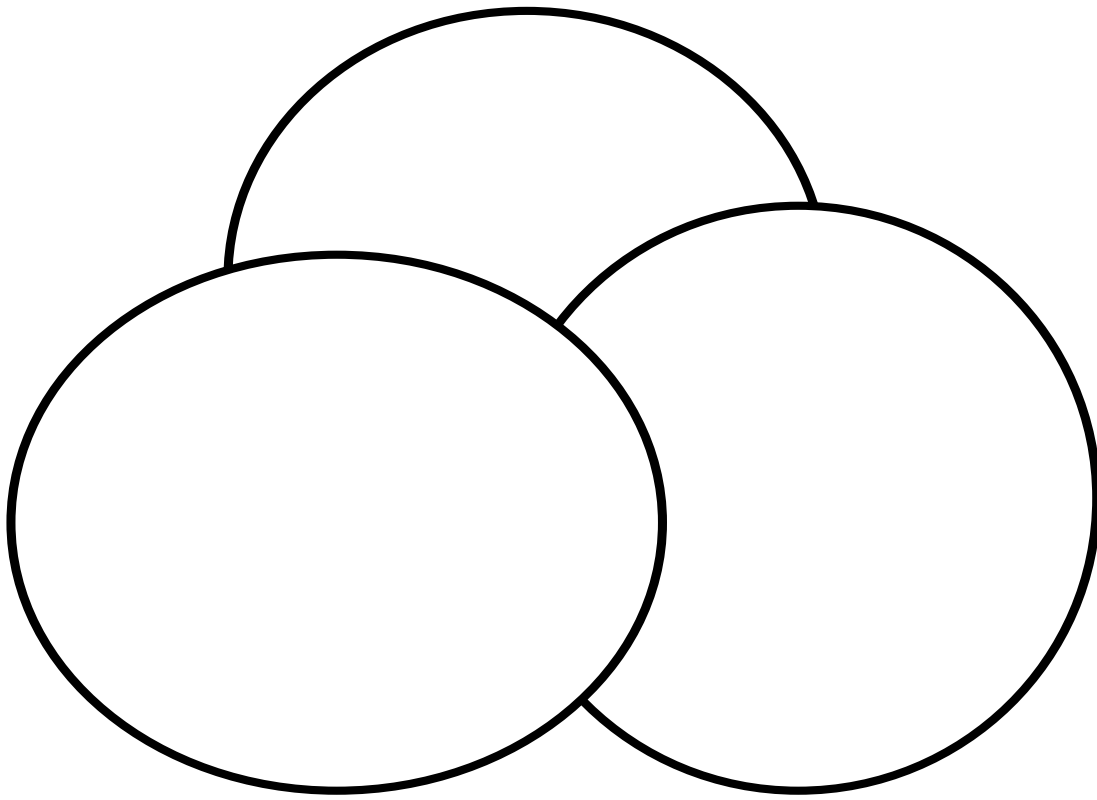
Venn Diagram
